Oh, well then, Sebastian, here is a generic PrintName procedure that works with *all* IDL-supplied objects that can have a name:

PRO PrintName, object object -> GetProperty, Name=theName Print, theName END

I'll leave it as an exercise for the reader to figure out what to do if the object *doesn't* have a name field. :-)
