- > What I find even worse is, that memory is NOT reclaimed
- > by the operating system when I exit IDL! But when I restart
- > IDL, it seems to be capable to somehow reuse that lost memory!?!> However, the wasted memory is lost for other applications.

I've never heard of anything like this, but I find it hard to believe this kind of memory problem is IDL's fault. Have you searched Sun's web page for patches to SOLARIS? It seems more probable to me that the solution will be found there rather than here.
