- > independent, either. This concept is foreign to the Windows
- > operating system, so RSI has hacked a substitute. As a result,
- > some tracking events are missed, depending (I suppose) on
- > where the cursor is when the tracking event "fires". You
- > have pretty good luck if you move your cursor s-l-o-w-l-y.

It has come to my attention that this little problem has been fixed in IDL 5.6. I have to admit I haven't tried it lately, and I haven't had a chance to test this since I learned about it, but it is from an impeccable source. :-)

So I think JD's little hack might work well on all platforms.
