- > TRACKING_EVENTS on the top-level widget base, and explicitly give the
- > appropriate widget focus when entering the application.

Unfortunately, TRACKING_EVENTS is not completely platform independent, either. This concept is foreign to the Windows operating system, so RSI has hacked a substitute. As a result, some tracking events are missed, depending (I suppose) on where the cursor is when the tracking event "fires". You have pretty good luck if you move your cursor s-l-o-w-l-y.
