> Display connection. In other words, an equivalent to:  
>  
> XFlush(display)  
>  
> Is this possible? I am trying to find out when I can assume a Pixmap  
> that I'm having IDL draw to is up-to-date, and I think there is a timing  
> issue with queued requests for me...

Try either FLUSH or EMPTY (or both). :-)
