At the risk of monopolizing my own discussion, here's a function I prepared that does both jobs. It first checks to see if the function has already been compiled. That's good for the runtime distribution where all objects must be precompiled. If that fails, it looks in the directories for the __define.pro file. TRUE (1b) is returned if the class exists. FALSE (0b) is returned if it fails.
