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The solution recommended by James Jay Jones at IDL's tech support is to use `obj_class()`.

I don't think I've ever used `obj_class()`. There's a first time for everything. Here's the RTFM moment:

Syntax

`Result = OBJ_CLASS( [Arg] [, COUNT=variable] [, /SUPERCLASS{must specify Arg}] )`

Return Value

Returns a string containing the name of the class or superclass. If the supplied argument is not an object, a null string is returned. If no argument is supplied, `OBJ_CLASS` returns an array containing the names of all known object classes in the current IDL session.
