The solution recommended by James Jay Jones at IDL's tech support is to use obj_class().

I don't think I've ever used obj_class(). There's a first time for everything. Here's the RTFM moment:

Syntax

Result = OBJ_CLASS([Arg] [, COUNT=variable] [, /SUPERCLASS{must specify Arg}])

Return Value

Returns a string containing the name of the class or superclass. If the supplied argument is not an object, a null string is returned. If no argument is supplied, OBJ_CLASS returns an array containing the names of all known object classes in the current IDL session.
