The example allows you to open a text widget and return the answer to your program. Your program will be slightly more elaborate than this, but will work on exactly the same principles.

```
IDL> theName = TextBox(Label='What is your name? ', $
    Value='Unknown', Cancel=cancelled)
IDL> IF NOT cancelled THEN Print, theName
```
