Kolbjorn Bekkelund (kolbjorn@arctic-linux.tnett.no) writes:

- > How do I manage to scale the two sides of the plot so that it can
- > show both the left yaxis (wind speeds) and the right one
- > (direction) with correct scales?

You need to add a SAVE keyword to your AXIS command. Otherwise, you will not change the !Y.S system variable that converts a point in data space to a point on the display. In other words, without it your next OPLOTT plots in the \*old\* axis range, not the new one you just drew.
