- > Sure! Just issue the compiler option in your main session:

> IDL> i=1 > IDL> help,i > I INT = 1 > IDL> compile\_opt IDL2 > IDL> i=1 > IDL> help, i > I LONG = 1

> This will stick until you reset your IDL session.

## Duh!

I guess I can be forgiven since the docs say:

"The COMPILE\_OPT statement allows the author to give the IDL compiler information that changes some of the default rules for compiling the function or procedure within which the COMPILE\_OPT statement appears."

So does everyone have

COMPILE\_OPT IDL2

in their startup.pro?

RESET\_SESSION does not re-run the startup.pro file, does it?
