> I've installed the June 2nd updates, I am running on Windows
> 2000 and Windows XP machines, and trying to print on HP Deskjet
> 990cse and 970cse printers. I've even tried selecting a PostScript
> printer and printing to a file. The file is completely empty
> when viewed with GhostView.

> We are all a little perplexed, as you can imagine. :-)
