With it, one can do amazing search things, and send them to a list box, filter them and zip them up, etc etc. It also nicely integrates ftp and such. Another good thing is that one can make buttons to "cd" you to a particular directory, which is really convenient.

A free fully functioning demo is available. Check it out at ghisler.com. And it is dirt cheap too (30\$) for the registered version.
