graphics or object graphics?

Which version of idl did you use?

set_plot,'ps'  
plot,findgen(10)  
device,/close  
set_plot,'X'
```

This gives a postscript file by directgraphics. It would be printed fine
on a 300dpi printer as well on a 1200dpi printer.

Normally Postscript is a vector driven format, so the printer knows how
to print it in differnt dpi's.
