set_plot,'ps' plot,findgen(10) device,/close set plot,'X'

This gives a postscript file by directgraphics. It would be printed fine on a 300dpi printer as well on a 1200dpi printer.

Normally Postscript is a vector driven format, so the printer knows how to print it in differnt dpi's.
