Hi there!

I've been away from this group for some time.. too many thing to do, too less time.

I am having trouble with our two new (well, some years ago they were new) SUN Ultra2 workstations and IDL (5.2). Whan I start IDL, and enter the WINDOW command, a white window appears. If I move the mouse cursor into the window, I get the correct black color, but my desktop colors switch, too.

I know this from other SUNs, but it never was a real problem, as switching to pseudo color mode (DEVICE, PSEUDO=8) or setting DEVICE, DECOMPOSED=0 solved it.

This does not work with the new SUNs. All I can do is a device, true_color, this prevents the color flickering. But I have tons of programs using pseudo color mode that I don't want to change to true-color mode.

Any ideas? I'm sorry that I don't know much about the graphics card, only that it's a Creator model, that's what the logo on the front panel says. We have other SUNs (Ultra-1), with Creator 3d cards, and they work well. I don't think there is an easy solution, but I thought I'd give the group here a try.
