>>> % Loaded DLM: HDF.

>>> IDL stops at the end line.

>>> I have checked out my HDF file and it appears to be fine

>>> Does anyone have any suggestions as to why this is happening?

This whole business of "Compiled module: \$MAIN is suspicious.

Are you sure you don't have another END statement in that file? I think you are running an empty main program rather than the program you *think* you are running. :-)

Try just compiling the HDF file by itself:

IDL> .compile HDF

If you don't get an "Compiled module: \$MAIN" nonsense, then just run the HDF file itself:

IDL> HDF

I suspect that will work.
