- > button that would bring the secondary in a different floating widget.
- > However he now wants me to integrate the secondary into a widget\_tab
- > in the main one. The thing is that I am wondering if it could be
- > possible to integrate the widgets (each one has a file with event
- > handlers and widget construction commands) with minimum changes and
- > keeping them in separate files. I just don't want to have huge files
- > and try to reuse the code as much as I can.

Sure, just write the second program to take the tab base widget  
ID from the first as a parameter and you are all set. :-)
