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If IDL didn't check for a .pro file for the method then feature you want would only check for *compiled* methods. Does not seem reasonable because having a method in a separate .pro file is not uncommon. Besides,

- > IDL will spend a significant amount of time
- > searching the path for a file with the name

is an overstatement. I am not sure what file system one must have for this to become a problem.

I would stick with error catching.
