- > After a quick browsing of the source, I think your problem is that you can't
- > reliably have 2 AVI streams open at once. There are a few global vars that
- > seem to clash.

That was my assessment also, but it's curious because the IDLtoAVI documentation makes a point of mentioning how the file identifiers returned by the open routines are unique and allow multiple AVI files to be open at once.

> What happens when you:

- > Open AVI1 for read
- > Open AVI2 for write (set different dimensions than source)
- > Read AVI1 and display on screen.

This actually works, it is only the close operation that causes the crash. Your workaround is doable though. Thanks.
