Between this and the original error messages, I'm pretty sure that your driver is broken with respect to texture mapping.

I would switch IDL to software rendering as I noted in my previous post and start looking for driver fixes.

The only other thing that might be worth doing is to find a really simple stand-alone OpenGL sample program that does texture mapping and see if that runs. If it does not, then you have a simple test case that reproduces the problem which is good to have if you report the problem to Matrox or whoever is working on the drivers.
