- > % READ_JPEG: JPEG error: Unsupported JPEG process: SOF type 0xc3

- > The images are pretty big so think they might be lossless jpeg. I know
- > this was covered in a previous thread but no satisfactory answer
- > seemed to have been found.
- >
- > Paint Shop Pro does not have any problem reading in the images.

I think this might be a case of Paint Shop Pro being well ahead of the curve. This does, apparently, refer to a lossless JPEG format. Perhaps you can save the images in Paint Shop Pro in a lossless PNG format that can be read by IDL.
