> 6.0 for evaluation, with
> !version.os_family = 'unix' on a Mac G4.
>
> I would love to know why the where() function is causing this trouble
> and how to fix it.

I seriously doubt the WHERE function (my vote for *the* most useful function in IDL) is causing this trouble. More likely a problem with the a path variable, or something of that sort.

I know the Mac versions of IDL tend to store information from one IDL session to the other. I don't know off-hand where this information is stored, but I'd try to find out and delete the file, so you can start over from scratch. I'm pretty sure if you did that the WHERE function would be miraculously restored. :-)
