    IF count GT 0 THEN y[2*x[I]] = !Values.F_NAN
> Is that close?
Assigning an element to [] is a simple way to delete it.
e.g.
>> a=[1,2,3,4]
```

>> a=[1,2,3,4] a = 1 2 3 4 >> a(3)=[] a = 1 2 4
