Not so. Object graphics output to Postscript can be done in raster or vector form, depending on the setting of the VECTOR keyword.

However to the best of my knowledge, vector Postscript output is not available from iTools. There are probably two reasons for this:

- * Nobody got around to it
- * Vector renditions of object graphics have various peculiarities and limitations, as described in the documentation.

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
