I've seen that IDL doesn't refresh windows. If I have an application and simply minimize e get the window again the image on the window is lost. This is particularly annoying when you have a window (made by widget draw) that has a size greater then the window you have defined and you use a scroll bar. When you go down on your image you don't see anything at all. This can be avoided by using the keyword EXPOSURE EVENTS on the widget draw. But this makes the application slower.

Two questions:

This happens only in the Unix operating system? (I work with both Window and Unix and this, as far as I've seen, doesn't happen in Windows) Anyone knows why?

Is there any solution that not the keyword EXPOSURE EVENTS?
