Unfortunately I'm using Windows, so the only thing I can do is to realize a widget draw as final widget, with dimensions exactly like widget base group leader and background color (ERASE procedure) as I want.

This solution is right for the widget button and widget draw realized on the base, but for widget label background color is always the default one (sigh!!!)
