This gives the wrong result if there's a constant difference between the arrays. For example.

a = [3,4,5,3]b = [2,3,4,2]

then max(a-b) = max([1,1,1,1]) = 1 yet min(a-b) = min([1,1,1,1]) = 1 So they're equal, but the arrays aren't.
