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I have the following issue with widget handling:

I have a main screen to my program, namely `screen_100`. The top level base widget for this happens to be `"w_bas_main"`. I have created another modal screen, `screen_200` that has `"w_bas_main"` to be it's group leader.

When I first run the program, I simply move the screen_100 to some arbitrary position on the screen. When I invoked screen_200, I expected the modal screen_200 to appear directly above screen_100, possibly overlapping a certain area of screen_100 (as illustrated below).

Sadly, modal screen_200 always appears at the left top corner of the screen, no matter where the main screen, screen_100 is positioned.
