Hi folks...

map\_set is giving me some headache since days...I'm trying to create in batch modus under linux some maps ( shell script is calling up IDL and starting the progs). The problem is this

When calling map\_set while being in the batch routines with the following arguments:

```
map_set,47.6445,9.29510,LIMIT=[47.4520,8.77010,47.8370,9.820 10]
```

IDL returns:

```
MAP_SET_LIMITS: Warning, MAP limits are invalid.
```

Well, If I just state this command not being in the batch modus: everything is going to be fine....

Any ideas? are the !MAP parameters messed up? Is there a way to set them back to standards? I tried also the SCALE keyword, which works, but because I got quite a bunch of maps with different scales...no way.... Thanks for your hints in advance...
