A while ago I asked a question about how to get current line number and module name for runtime logging. A few people correctly suggested using HELP, tb = CALLS giving all necessary traceback information in the string array tb.

BUT:  
My application uses SAVE files, that is - during the make process (Yes, I actually use a Makefile for IDL), I get idl to compile all routines necessary for the application, and then issue the commands  
save,/all,/verb,filename="appvars.img"  
save,/rou,/verb,filename="appproc.img"

And the executable application is then simply the script

```
idl << `tail -3 $0`  
restore, filename='appvars.img'  
restore, filename='appproc.img'  
browse_task  
exit
```

The problem is that when using precompiled images the linenumbers seem to disappear from the traceback info.  
Is there a solution/workaround for this?
