> ;; Make a list of indices  
> ii = lindgen(n_elements(x))  
>  
> ;; Select on X and the index variable  
> wh = where(x GE 0 AND ii LT 200)
```

While this is an example of using the index variable,
this statement by itself can be shortened to

```
wh = where(x[0:199] ge 0)
```
