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At last, thanks to some suggetions, I seem to have solved the problem: if I clean the RAM of my PC (i.e. with CLEANRAM software) after every classification, I have comparable processing times, independently from previous elaborations.

Maybe this isn't the correct way to make benchmarking, but since a classification is tipically a process wich is executed only once, I think that the processing times that I calculate in this way can be considered representative of a "real" application.
