I use the Thomas Oettli's procedures for the CIA World Map dataset available from ftp.sma.ch. Apart from having a higher resolution dataset, it has the ability to fill the continental polygons with an arbitrary colour.

The routines are straightforward to use, only slightly more complicated than the IDL routines (an index file has to be preloaded)

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
