put something like this in your startup file, (or type on the command line).

!path = !path + "+/full/path/to/fanning/programs:"

The '+' means include all subdirectories under this one. And now that I've started answering this, I'm not sure I know the whole answer. In my startup I also have the following line, which may do the expansion of all the subdirectories.

!path = expand_path(!path)

All I know forsure is you can't go wrong if you put fanning's libs in your path. :)
