But it just hangs after > saying 'Loaded DLM: JPEG'. It's problem with .png image too. > # I just discovered that XPLOT3D procedure also doesn't work. It also > hangs. > I have RH-9 on my laptop. And I am using IDL 5.5. It seems to me that > my linux is missing some libs or something like that. > Has anybody faced this problem before?
