- > appear to be directly related to the code. It happens using several
- > different computers. I've tried loading IDL locally rather than
- > running over the network and turning my virus checker off, but all to
- > no avail.

- > Has anyone seen similar problems any clues as to what might be the
- > cause?

I'm dealing with something similar--a program that won't run twice in succession unless a window is opened between times. But it appears to be machine-specific. I'm leaning toward a bad bit of RAM at the moment, but have found nothing definite yet. Save Windows XP system with IDL 6.03.
