Any ideas as to the source of my problem:

I'm running IDL 6.0 under Windows XP (but still get the problem when I tried it on Windows 2000).

I'm running an IDL project which intermittently crashes out (kills IDL) just after jumping into a particular procedure. It happens at either one of two points in the program and is intermittent so doesn't appear to be directly related to the code. It happens using several different computers. I've tried loading IDL locally rather than running over the network and turning my virus checker off, but all to no avail.

Has anyone seen similar problems - any clues as to what might be the cause?
