Hello everyone,

I have written a (very simple) procedure which displays data points on an xy-axis and allows you to manipulate them using the left mouse button (i.e. it just uses tvrdc,x,y,/down to get the point-within a specified range-and reads the position of the next click to place it). At the moment all it does is re-plot every time you move a point and although it is satisfactory for my purposes it takes a while to get the plot line looking smooth. Clearly it would be neater if i could drag the points and have the screen continually update the plot so i could see the original line itself moving with the cursor. I expect it to be fairly simple but have looked in the IDI manual/reference guide and at the library routines for clues and have found nothing helpful. Does anyone know what commands i should be using? Any help would be appreciated.
