I ran into this same problem before, under the same circumstances as you. It is especially annoying because, in my case, each file was a satellite track, so my analysis would sneakily drop the occasional orbit. argh! (only seemed to be a problem when there were ~10,000 files) I ended up just spawning out the the OS and getting a directory listing. (and writing a check to make sure that if an orbit was missing, that it was really missing).
