You could open a python process with SPAWN and then use shared memory to send data between the processes. Since you're working on "huge amounts of data," shared memory would probably be the easiest way to go. The gotcha to this is that you will probably have to be careful how you read/write data to the shared memory to make sure that values are converted between IDL and Python correctly. Don't know if that helps or not. Happy trails,
