AUTO_WID_MNG (and use the /auto keyword in that widget definition.
For instance:

wg = widget_slablel(base, prompt = 'My List')
wm = widget_multi(base, list=['1','2'], uvalue='list', /auto)
result = auto_wid_mng(base)
```
