> to output this number to a text file as a number rounded to two
> decimal places. In other words, I want to output to a text file
> "200.23".
>
> How do I do this? I've looked into the ROUND function but only rounds
> to the nearest integer.

Something like this should work:

```
PrintF, lun, data, Format='(F8.2)'
```
