We are currently using Oracle in our production databases. However, I have played around with MySQL and there the only minor differences with regards to the database connectivity.

To really gauge how much work it would be is dependent on whether you've done a lot of C database programming before. When I took on the task of integrating IDL and Java, it took a few hours to get something basic running, but I was already familiar with JDBC and the IDL-Java bridge.
