I noted the hoopla about benchmarks running on pentiums, SGI's, suns, and about every other machine, and I thought I would include some local machines for this list. This is running the TIME\_TEST benchmark.

SGI 4D/340S (4 CPU) 37.2 seconds {usual loaded-down state}

4D/310S (1 CPU) 39.9 {loaded}

SGI Indy 17.7 {nobody}

DECstation 5000/200 79.4 {nobody on}

DEC Alpha (64 MB RAM) 13.3 {two other jobs}

DEC Alpha (254 MB) 7.0 {nobody}

The Alpha times seem to indicate this who procedure is heavily swap-dependent, which is not too big a surprise I suppose. The big SGI's aren't too revealing, as they are pretty loaded down and I didn't ever get a chance to try them otherwise.
