Personally, I do ALL of my development work on \*nix. Once the program has been completely tested out on \*nix, I will then check that it runs the same way on Windows. All of the core logic has been debugged by this point, so the only errors which would arise would be ones if platform specific code managed to accidentally creep in. I also do the same thing for my Java, Python, et al. programs -- develop on Linux and test completely, then move them to Windows and make sure they still work the same way. In short, I just develop by the credo "Spend as little time as possible on Windows."
