  The problem is that if I enter a null string or click the cancel
  button I get the following error message back out:
  "WIDGET_LABEL: String expression required in this contact: LABEL."

> I don't understand this at all! Any help on this much appreciated.

It means that whatever you have in the variable "inputname" isn't a string. Try putting a "HELP, inputname" just before the call the TEXTBOX to see what it is.
