- > So, is there anyway to get the IDLWAVE to run a given script before
- > starting IDL?

Couple of options: define your environment variables in an emacs startup like this:

(setenv "IDL_STARTUP" (concat CUBISM_REPOS "/idl_start"))

or just make sure your the emacs session in which IDL is running is launched from within a shell which correctly sets the environment (emacs then inherits the environment of the shell).
