> isn't a string. Try putting a "HELP, inputname" just before

> the call the TEXTBOX to see what it is.

For some reason I was initially entering a string but it was returning inputname as a float (!?!). I got around this by copying the input string into a temporary variable and copying it back to the original variable if the textbox needed to be reopened.
