I generated a ternary plot(a triangular coordinate system which indicates the relative scale of three quantities) which I am exporting to a PS file and I want to add some indication of the real scale of the numbers. I created it using direct graphics with some plot and xyouts commands.

Anyway, I'd like to add a simple table to the plot listing the numbers. But I am not sure of the most efficient way to do this. I guess one way would be to try multiple plots and put a grid on one axis, with the ternary diagram on the other, but it would be nice to overlap them some.

Is direct graphics the way to go? or should I try ans switch to object graphics.
